APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL AID
POST-SECONDARY TRAINING FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE BLIND OR VISUALLY IMPAIRED

Scholarships are awarded to students graduating from high school who are blind or visually impaired, who are commencing post-secondary studies, and who are under 21 years of age. **Applications must be supported by evidence of acceptance into a post-secondary program, current transcript, three letters of reference (character, academic and one other), and a recent report from an eye specialist stating your corrected visual acuity. All supporting documents must be attached. Incomplete applications will not be considered.** An individual student may be awarded up to \$1,500 for any one year provided an award is not received from the S.R. Hussey Memorial Trust Fund. Scholarships and bursaries to a maximum of \$10,000 are awarded annually in accordance with these guidelines.

Selection criteria:

- ▶ person must show potential for success in chosen program
- ▶ financial need
- ▶ resident of Atlantic Canada

The Trust Fund Committee will receive applications for APSEA Scholarships for Post Secondary Education until **April 1st**. Completed application with supporting documentation must be submitted by **April 1st** to:
