

Considerations for School-based Education Teams for Supporting Learners who are Participating in APSEA Virtual Programs

APSEA team members work collaboratively with School-Based Education Team members to identify and support appropriate APSEA virtual learning opportunities for the learners. Below are some suggestions for both APSEA and School-based Education team members to support this process.



Preparation and Scheduling

The APSEA team member will:

- Meet with the school-based education team to discuss the program, including the roles of each of the team members involved.
- Demonstrate setting up the computer with the school-based education team and the learner.
- Work collaboratively with the student and school-based education team to outline the meeting schedule.
- Mail and/or e-mail materials to the school for use during the session and for review/practice if applicable.



Technology Needs

The school-based education team will:

- Provide the basic technology for the learner to access the virtual program. APSEA may provide additional technology if required.
- Provide internet access the learner that is fast enough for live streaming and free from any firewall restrictions.



Steps to Success

The school-based education team will:

- Determine a guiet location where the learner will access the APSEA virtual program.
- Support learner's schedule to participate in the APSEA virtual program.
- Designate a school team member as the key contact.
- Designate a school team member who will escort the learner to the chosen location and be present with the learner throughout the virtual program.
